Payments may be mailed, please indicate on the on-line form, in the comment section, Ck # and amount, remember to include your return address. Rita's will be in contact with her house sitter to verify payment was received.

RITA does accept on-line payments – Note any payments made on-line require an additional Handling Fee of \$4.00 per entry. One dog in four classes is considered 4 entries so \$16.00 handling fees. One dog running two or three times is considered as 2 or 3 entries so handling fee for 2 is \$8.00, fee for 3 is \$12.00

All entries must be received by Rita no later than Oct 30, 2020 6 pm. Fees if by check must be received at 2945 Slivkoff Dr, Escondido, CA 92027, Trial Secretary's address.no later than: 6:00 pm, Friday, Oct 30, 2020.

Do not send payments by any method which requires a signature for delivery!

All entries must be signed or the acceptance box checked for on-line entries. Not only are Both entries and fees required to be considered a completed entry, the Covid 19 Waiver must also be signed or electronically signed and sent in with Entry Form. To LetitBk9@cox.net.

Please note, a check can be mailed to show secretary's address payable to GSDCSGV. Or a charge card can be used through PayPal, if paying on-line there is a \$4.00 handling fee per entry/event. (Example: dog is entered in Bred-By and puppy that is considered two entries or a dog who does conformation and one rally class is considered two events. Both example would have a handling fee of \$8.00). A completed entry requires both entry and payment.

Due to COVID 19, a waiver must accompany your entry/entries

ADDITIONAL TEST/TRIAL REGULATIONS

Masks are required at all times.

We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping keep the shows/trials location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of this facility for future show/trials.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entries must be received at the Trial Secretary's address by the published closing date to be acceptable, and may not be changed, substituted, corrected, signed or cancelled after that time. Incomplete, unsigned, conditionals, telephone, telegraph, or entries received without fees are not acceptable. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will assess a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put upon a cash-only basis.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, judge or tester or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. Checks are payable to GSDCSGV

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog that does not appear within five minutes of being called. The Show/Trial-giving Club and the Test/Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authority, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulation will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

SPECIAL COVID-19 TRIAL GUIDELINES

Mask Will be Required



These trials will not be operating "business as usual." Hosting a trial and exhibiting is a privilege. It will be up to all of us to do our best and do it right!

We will be adhering to State of California, County of Ventura, and City of Moorpark public health regulations in addition to CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers and exhibitors as safe as possible.

GENERAL PRACTICES - Clubs, officials & participants are required to follow state, local & facility guidelines that apply to the area & site where the event is held. Exhibitors should wash hands as frequently as possible, Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Avoid common use pens/pencils - bring your own. Exhibitors must provide their own scoops for cleaning up from their dogs in and around showgrounds. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks. Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.

1. If you feel unwell, have a fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat, (or any others symptoms that have been associated with COVID-19), please stay home.
2. TO COVID-19 If within 14 days prior to the trials you have been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has the symptoms noted above, please stay home.
3. Physical Distancing: Maintain at least six feet between you and other exhibitors or spectators at all times. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid physical contact, (shaking hands or hugging). Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility,
4. Face Masks: Per State of California health orders, face masks are required at all times while outside of ones home where physical distancing is not possible. Exhibitors may wish to familiarize dogs to that "look" before the event. The show committees plan on allowing exhibitors to lower their face mask while in the ring exhibiting. Anyone lowering their face mask while in the ring must correctly reposition their mask before exiting the ring. Please note that additional public health orders put in place on or before the day of our trials may not allow this. Anyone who refuses to wear mask outside the ring will be required to leave the showgrounds. Exhibitors must supply their own masks!
5. Parking: Park with increased distance between vehicles wherever possible. This is especially critical if handlers are crating from their vehicles.
6. Show and go: Please do not remain on showgrounds any longer than necessary. You and your dog should only be on the grounds to; acclimate, warm-up, walk course (if applicable), exhibit, collect ribbons/prizes. Once your event(s) have concluded, please leave showgrounds..
7. Crating/Shade: If entered in only one class, please crate from your vehicle if practical to do so. If you do crate from your vehicle, please be cognizant of weather conditions (heat), bring adequate shade for your vehicle or consider leaving vehicle running with air conditioning on, etc. If entered in multiple classes and plan on bringing canopy onto showgrounds for shade, please maintain at least six feet of separation between your canopy and any neighboring canopies. Do not share canopy with anyone that is not from your immediate household. If you are asked to move farther away - PLEASE DO IT.
8. Check-In without your dog. Stay behind the tape line to maintain six-foot distance from stewards/secretary, If there is a line, maintain at least six feet between you and the next person. When asked, give your armband number and class(es) and you will receive your armband.
9. Prizes: At the conclusion of each class, judge will call qualifiers into the ring.
 - a. Maintain a minimum of six feet between you and other individuals in the ring. Your dog need not be present for this ceremony and if possible please leave dog crated.
 - b. Steward will sanitize hands before sorting ribbons.
 - c. Steward will place the ribbons on the table and exhibitor will pick up on their way out of the ring.
10. Spectators: To minimize the number of people on the showgrounds, spectators are not recommended - this includes spouses or significant others. Only handlers and their dogs should come to the trial.
11. Judges and stewards will maintain social distance as practical in and around the ring between each other, exhibitors and spectators- Hand sanitizer or washing supplies will be available at ring(s). Gloves will also be provided to judges, stewards and show committee members who wish to have another layer of protection. Avoid shared use of pens/pencils.
12. Lunch will be on your own for all exhibitors, judges, stewards, and committee members. Prepackaged snacks and water will be available for judges, stewards and committee members only.
13. Video Recording: Please do not handle someone else phone to video a performance. Consider recording using your own device and transfer video electronically.

Any person who fails to follow these guidelines at all times during these events or on the showgrounds during show hours will be investigated by the trial committee for misconduct prejudicial to the interests of the sport and may result in expulsion from this event and possible sanction by AKC.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, Rosettes, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
